



## **Good Friday\***

*Put a cedar branch (from Palm Sunday) on the front door until Pentecost (May 31<sup>st</sup>).*

*One red candle is lit. A wooden cross is placed on the table.*

One: Why do we blow out the candle today?

**All: Today is Good Friday. This is the day that we remember that Jesus died.**

Reading: Mark 15:25-41 or *Jesus Storybook Bible* p. 302, "The sun stops shining"

*Pause for a moment and then blow out the red candle.*

*Everyone is quiet for a moment.*

\*Feel invited to adjust these symbols (branch, candle, cross) based on what you have in your home. For example, you could draw a cross and ask your children to colour it in if you don't have a wooden one or use a different colour than red for the candle.
